What is Shroom?

In keeping with LOMBOK's inspiration of Wood & Travel, the concept for this set of furniture was inspired by the clusters of fungi one may find growing on the bark of trees, and the different layers that this creates.



Design Language

The main characteristics of this design are the different layers created from the same material, which create a soft movement, and geometric pattern. There is a subtle balance between masculine and feminine energy. Where the crisp edges of the chair may awaken a sense of masculinity, the soft round curves which they follow bring a feminine presence into the atmosphere, merging these two ends of the spectrum together in harmony.

The table creates a simple yet effective pattern. Once again bringing a sense of movement, as the base becomes bigger towards the top, and the arrangement of the pattern creates a sense of growth.



Materials

Cork: the main material is moulded cork. It is a highly sustainable material with very unique properties. Due to its rather soft and spongy feel, it has a youthful and airy effect on a space. Its warm light brown tones create a welcoming and relaxing atmosphere.

Wool Felt: the chair will be upholstered in wool felt. In combination with the cork, this will bring a very natural and organic ambience, while also imitating the colours and textures of mushrooms.

Mirrored Steel: in order to create a durable design, the base of the table and rod that runs through the middle of the table are made of mirrored steel. The mirrored effect preserves the natural properties of the cork and wool, as it reflects them back, while simultaneously adding an element of sleek design. There is also a 2cm mirrored steel ribbon that runs around the legs of the armchair, to create a coherency between the two objects.
